You are about to purchase a product that is not simple and may be difficult to understand.

What is this product?

Type

The Sub-fund is part of INCOMETRIC FUND, organized under the laws of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg as a mutual investment fund. This Fund is authorised and supervised in Luxembourg by the CSSF. The Depositary is Quintet Private Bank (Europe) S.A.

Term

The investment horizon is medium term and should be at least 3 years.

Objectives

The Sub-Fund is actively managed. The Sub-Fund's investment objective is to achieve a total return over a rolling 3 year period, in its Reference Currency by mainly investing in UCITS or UCIs in accordance with Section "Investment Restrictions".

The investment strategy of the Sub-Fund will privilege UCITS or UCIs investing primarily in Europe and the United States of America.

The Sub-Fund may also invest up to 20% of its net assets in worldwide equities, bonds, money market instruments and derivatives in accordance with Section "Investment Restrictions".

The aforementioned investment strategy corresponds for the investors to a medium investment risk.

For treasury purposes the Sub-Fund may also invest in liquid instruments according to the criteria of article 41(1) of the 2010 Law such as (but not limited to) money market instruments and money market funds and bank deposits.

The Sub-Fund may hold ancillary liquid assets limited to bank deposits at sight with a maximum of 20% of the net assets of the Sub-Fund in order to cover current or exceptional payments, or for the time necessary to reinvest in eligible assets provided under article 41(1) of the Law of 2010 or for a period of time strictly necessary in case of unfavorable market conditions. Ancillary liquid assets do not include bank deposits, money market instruments, money market funds and other instruments that meet the criteria of article 41(1) of the 2010 Law.For hedging and for investment purposes, the Sub-Fund may use financial derivative instruments products traded on a regulated market and/or over the counter (OTC), provided they are contracted with first class financial institutions specialized in this type of transactions.

Intended retail investor

Reserved for financial intermediaries and denominated in Euro. The investment strategy corresponds for the investors to a medium investment risk. Minimum Initial Investment: EUR 15,000.

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 3 years.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because the fund is not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 4 out of 7, which is a medium risk class.

This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium level, and poor market conditions could impact our capacity to pay you.

The stress scenario shows what you might get back in extreme market circumstances.

Unfavourable scenario: This type of scenario occurred for an investment between 27/10/2021 and 26/10/2022 (If you exit after 1 year), 29/03/2017 and 25/03/2020 (If you exit after 3 years).

Moderate scenario: This type of scenario occurred for an investment between 27/11/2019 and 25/11/2020 (If you exit after 1 year), 28/09/2016 and 25/09/2019 (If you exit after 3 years).

Favourable scenario: This type of scenario occurred for an investment between 25/03/2020 and 31/03/2021 (If you exit after 1 year), 31/12/2018 and 31/12/2021 (If you exit after 3 years).

What happens if Adepa Asset Management S.A. is unable to pay out?

Costs over Time

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0 % annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.


